

## **Baby Clinic**

It is important that your child receives his / her childhood immunisations and we are committed to ensuring that we continue to deliver this service in a safe environment. With this in mind we have made some changes to how the clinics will run during the Covid-19 situation.

- Baby clinics will run from Wideopen surgery only (this is to reduce the risk of possible infection across both practices)
- Someone from the Practice will contact patients due to come in for their vaccinations with a dedicated appointment time. At the time of making the appointment you will be asked to ensure a mobile number is recorded on your child's record – this tends to be either mother or father. The mobile number must be the number of the person bringing the child to the appointment.
- Only one adult per child is allowed in the clinic
- When you arrive at the surgery, please press the intercom for assistance. A member of admin will confirm your appointment along with your mobile number and car registration (if applicable). If the waiting room is empty you will be asked to take a seat until the nurse calls you in
- If the waiting room is busy you will be asked to wait in your car (if applicable) or in the lobby. When the nurse is ready she will ring your mobile number and ask you to come inside or if in the lobby she will come and get you
- Please arrive on time to help manage the 'one in one out' system
